## 3. Previous meeting

3.1. Minutes of previous meeting – 22 August 2017

## 4. Correspondence

- 4.1. Letter from Emma Kealy, and response Dadswells Bridge
  - Kelvin waiting to hear back from Recycling Contractor on if they are prepared to go to these areas.

## 5. Issues Papers

- 5.1. Container Deposit Schemes
  - A matter primarily for the State Government
  - National study done. The preferred model is a packaging stewardship scheme where you pay a fee in the price of the item
  - Council has recently lobbied for a container deposit scheme, without result.

## 5.2. Garage Sail Trail Event

- Concept is great
- Level of impact is never going to high
- The time to be registered and the time for sale is not great
- Need someone on the ground to get people on board

- Service clubs could help with this?
- Things like café fixit or boomerang bags are great for the community

## 5.3. Recycling at Events

- Is getting some use
- Used for football finals at Coughlin Park there was a bit of contamination
- If there was a recycling centre in town then these could go there for sorting or contractor needs to pick up these bins
- If there is one bit of contamination in the bin, then whole bin goes to landfill
- Action: La Vergne to ask around and see what others have done in this situation
- Education is needed
- If the contaminant is the food waste, then why don't we have a food bin?
- Could the football clubs have more ownership? Could reward the clubs for good practices.

#### 5.4. Education

- North East Vic spend \$300k on education for 5 councils
- Having a number of discussions with groups about setting up composting systems.
- Golden Plains did a breakdown using a great picture of a bin. La Vergne has requested a copy of this for us to use.
- La Vergne has met with Biomax offers some likelihood of green waste receival
- Council garbage operators find that the recycling bins aren't utilised in certain areas
- Anything we do will have an education element to it
- The Waste Group will have some education in coming months on Ewaste and should tag onto this for other programs

## 5.5. Dooen Landfill Operation

- Costs a lot of money to run a landfill not many councils do it
- Needed to review whether Council should continue to operate Dooen Landfill
- Looked at carting waste to other landfills and worked out it was cheaper to continue to run our own
- Is there an opportunity in putting in a container and sending off? There is an issue with timing i.e putrescible waste

#### 5.6. Ban on E-waste

- Government will be rolling out education programs for this in the near future
- Horsham is ideally placed as we have Community Axis and Bits and Bytes.
- Bits and bytes offers free home pick up of anything electrical
- The e-waste associated with this ban is anything electrical eg toasters, kettles, hair dryers, electric toothbrushes

- There are infrastructure grants available in the next few weeks for.
- 5.7. Green waste stockpiles, energy
  - Sales at transfer station is near nothing
  - Is used for Motocross at moment
  - Biomass at Aquatic Centre does not have a good payback

# 5.8. Increased recovery of materials

- Building products is an area this can be increased
- Partly done have a new item for landfill chipped hard waste haven't nailed the solution for this
- Keen for committee to make suggestions on how we can improve in this area
- Building a new plant that can get gypsum down to 90% 10mm which he has a market for.
- Need to find a market for dried timber. Have the equipment for it but there is no market for this at the moment.
- Landfill levies are getting more so more and more are stockpiles.
- If a consultant can be found would Horsham be interested a grant for someone to do this audit? **Action: JM**
