Come along and discuss Council's Draft Budget and Draft Rates Strategy 2018-19 and Draft Council Plan 2018-22.

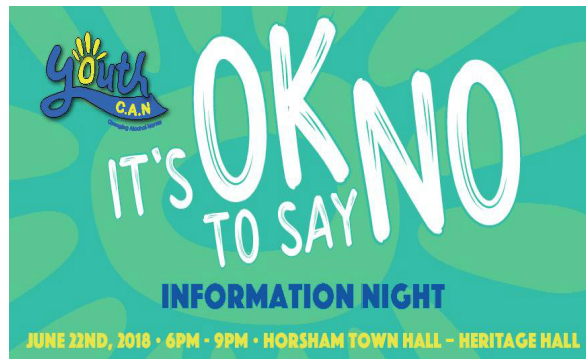
Brimpaen Recreation and Hall Reserve Meeting

Teenagers show what they think about alcohol

Parents, carers and teenagers will have the chance to gain an insight into the region's alcohol culture at a performance and information night coordinated by Council's Youth CAN (Changing Alcohol Norms) project and local schools.

The Youth CAN project seeks to see more people socially supporting one another to reduce risky drinking.

The event is in response to a recent Wimmera Drug Action Taskforce survey where 74% of Wimmera people said there wasn't enough alcohol and drug information provided locally.

The community performance and information night will feature comedian Fiona O'Loughlin as special guest speaker along with short plays performed by Year 10 students and information from local alcohol and other drug services in the region.

Ms O'Loughlin, the recent winner of I'm A Celebrity...Get Me Out Of Here! will discuss how she has overcome a serious alcohol addiction and made positive change in her life.

The performance and information night will be held on **Friday 22 June** at Horsham Town Hall (Heritage Hall) from 6pm until 9pm.

Entry is free, however a ticket is required and can be obtained from the Horsham Town Hall website.

The Youth CAN project is part of the VicHealth Alcohol Culture Change Initiative which aims to change cultures of risky drinking in Victoria.
