Master Plan development for Sunnyside Park

What is happening?

Horsham Rural City Council is seeking suggestions to develop a landscape master plan for Sunnyside Park.

Who has been involved so far?

The Sunnyside Park Advisory Committee and HRCC are working together on this project.

Why is this happening?

A master plan provides a framework so that as funds become available, facilities and upgrades can occur. The planning process also provides an opportunity to consider how the park is used and how it might be developed to better serve the needs of individuals, families and both sporting and social groups.

What has this first stage of consultation?

Consultation with committee members identified opportunities to create meeting and play spaces, improve pathways and movement through the park. Talks also found opportunities for sports groups and the community to work more closely.

What can you do?

Take time to consider the draft planning we have done by visiting the 'Have Your Say' page on Council's website. We are seeking your suggestions to help create a master plan so the park reflects your interests and is welcoming and safe for our community. You can submit feedback online and there is also an information session at Sunnyside Bowling Club on **Monday 21 May from 7.30pm to 8.30pm**. Alternatively, you can forward suggestions to Mandy Kirsopp at the Civic Centre, Roberts Ave, Horsham.

EasyPark code changes

Council is in the process of updating signage for parking area codes in Horsham on behalf of EasyPark.

Due to the growth of EasyPark across the country, the current area codes in Horsham will move from four digits to five.

All Horsham codes will simply have a '1' added at the start. For example: 1700 will become 11700.

Please check relevant signs and use the new parking area code as the previous codes will no longer be available.

Registering for the EasyPark system is quick and easy and the app can be downloaded from smartphone app stores.

Overdue animal registrations

Pet owners are reminded that unpaid registrations attract a fine of \$317. All dogs and cats, three months of age and over, must be microchipped and registered. Renewals are due 10 April each year. If your pet has passed away or moved to a new location, please let us know by completing an online form at hrcc.vic.gov.au/residents/animals-and-livestock/pet-ownership.
