FUNDING GUIDELINES

Funding is only for local not-for-profit organisations, groups and associations

The minimum allocation is \$2,500 and the maximum allocation per organisation is \$7,500.

Grant applications must identify how their project will improve the lives of people living with disability.

Applications open 7 May and close 15 June for projects that can start immediately and be completed by 31 December.
