Tim Flannery - Guest Speaker

Internationally acclaimed writer, scientist, explorer and conservationist Tim Flannery will be at Natimuk Soldiers Memorial Hall this **Friday 30 April** with a talk titled "Rising to the climate challenge through empowering communities".

Presented by Natimuk Community Energy, Professor Flannery will discuss how communities around Australia are creating sustainable energy and employment solutions. Tim will be outlining the importance of these initiatives, as well as explaining some programmes that are assisting them.

The evening will kick off with a celebration of the 10kW solar installation at Natimuk Football ground's Shearers Shed and a short update on other NCE projects, including a solar garden on the eastern edge of Natimuk that will produce enough electricity to power the town. Professor Flannery will then deliver his talk, and following an audience Q&A the event will wrap-up by 9.30pm.
