SUBJECT: Commemorative Cairns

Council at its meeting on 8th July, 1997 adopted the following policy:-

POLICY:

That, upon the receipt of requests for assistance in the provision of plaques and cairns to commemorate an historical event or location throughout the municipality and on the basis that the cairns relates to a relatively public event or site, Council provide a suitable rock (ex McKenzie Creek Quarry) at the site, after which the representative group is to arrange for installation of the rock and supply and fitting of the plaque.

Officers may assist in obtaining plaques if required and if other statutory or similar organisations were involved, then costs could be shared with Council.
