

Single Farming Enterprise Exemption Addition of New Property to Prior Application

Fire Services Property Levy and Municipal Charge

Part A - Information

Where multiple parcels of farm land are used to operate a single farming enterprise, a person may only be required to pay the fixed charge and municipal charge once by applying for the single farming enterprise exemption. To apply to have newly acquired properties added to an existing exemption, a person must submit this form, completed and signed, to the Council where the relevant new property is located. You must notify Council if the circumstances relating to your application change as this may affect your eligibility for the exemption.
