## **Bushfire Recovery Information**

Forest Fire Management Victoria (FFMVic) can assist landholders impacted by the bushfire events.

FFMVic can provide three types of assistance to repair or make good damage to land or assets caused by firefighting operations including:

- 1. repairs to fences cut or damaged by fire crews (CFA or FFMVic)
- 2. rehabilitation of dozer and grader control lines
- 3. replacement of essential water that has been taken by fire services

Repair of bushfire damaged fences on the boundary of public land:

- FFMVic can provide financial support for materials to replace or repair fences located on the boundary of private land and National Parks, State Parks and State Forests.
- The cost of materials will be based on replacement of the fence type that existed before the fire.
- Other bushfire damaged property boundary and internal fences are not covered by this assistance.
- Landholders are ineligible for support if their fences are covered by insurance.

If you believe you are eligible, please contact DEECA on 136 186 to register your details. You can also fill out the attached forms and email to emergency.recovery@deeca.vic.gov.au or drop it off at your closest DEECA Office. An assessor will be in contact to discuss eligibility and arrange an on-site inspection.
