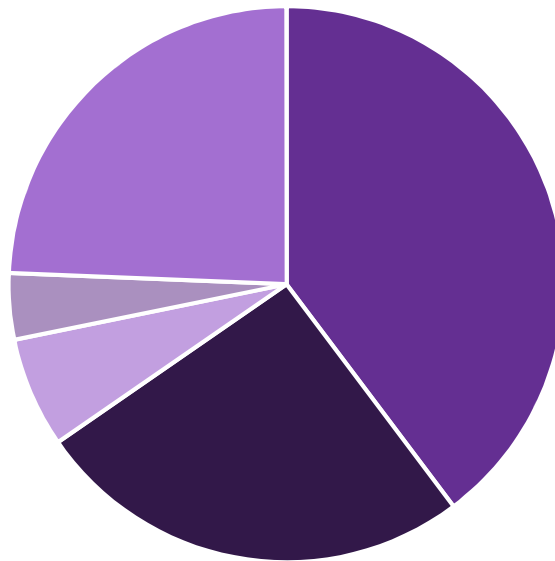

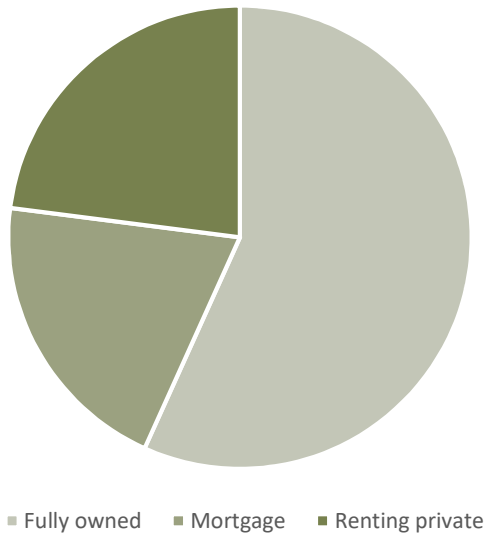

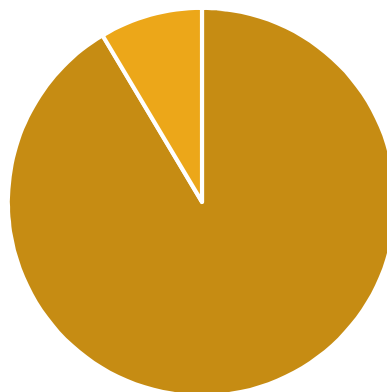
Relative socio-economic advantage and disadvantage

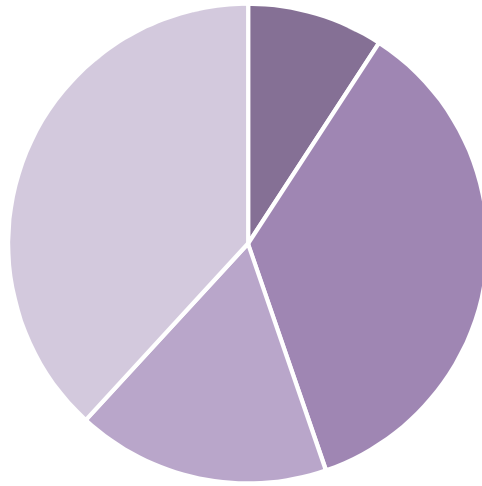
