

You can ask someone to help you read and understand this booklet.




We respect Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities of this land. We know these communities help to make our lives better.

 do disability awareness training and learn from people with disability



 share stories and pictures about how people with disability make our community better.

We will also have events for International Day of People with Disability and Carers Week.

  - for example, Easy Read




- train our staff to support people

We want everyone to be able to access our buildings, places and events.




#### We will

follow standards about making buildings,
 places and events accessible



 follow standards about clear signs in buildings and around the community



 ask people with disability about ways to improve access in our community



 fix buildings and places to make sure they are accessible and safe.



#### We will also

 make good paths so it is easy for people to move around the community



 make sure events meet the needs of people with disability



 have quiet places for people with disability in buildings and at events.

 work with different groups to increase job applications from people with disability



 train staff to make sure they support people with disability to do a good job
